Designed specifically for families who intend to home-educate their children. 475 hours of access to wonderful, innovative instruction. Follows the Alberta Curriculum, maximum 22 children.

Our Kindergarten program believes that children are active protagonists in their growing processes. Children are equipped with extraordinary potentials for learning and have passions for the arts, inquiry, investigation, initiative, imagination, engineering and ingenuity when engaging in a variety of creative processes to develop and explore ideas.







Why choose us?

The Kindergarten program and preschool work together to provide a solid beginning for families. Children develop the necessary skills for a successful elementary journey whether or not parents choose to homeschool. The teacher, acting as both mentor and role model, demonstrates how to research topics, how to design lessons and how to implement and evaluate a homeschool program.

Tuesdays and Thursdays

Kindergarten class starts at 9:00 AM and runs until 3:05 PM with half an hour for lunch. It makes for a fun, full day! It also means that families who live outside of Calgary only have to come to town two days a week.

STEAM activities

2 STEAM stands for Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math. The children do a lot of these kinds of activities! Plus, they have gym time, sign language instruction, music and lots of art.

Field Trips

The Kindergarten children explore a variety of places each year—such as the Calgary Zoo and Telus Spark. But some are closer like the big open field right next to the school. They also learn about community and nature through our neighbourhood walks and our bee hive.

Transportation Grant

Parents are responsible for transporting their children to and from the program and on field trips. The transportation grant from Alberta Education is provided to parents to help cover this expense.

Preschool

Each preschool class is set up to provide age appropriate learning aids, toys, games, puzzles and outdoor time to keep children stimulated while they socialize and learn.

Tuesdays &/or Thursdays 10 AM—NOON

Class Size - Phoenix class sizes are much smaller to ensure each child gets personal attention.

Max — 6 children

Class length - Not too long... young children need some structure tempered with some play time. Two hours is just enough time for children 3—4 years old.
