PRESCHOOL PROGRAM

Our Preschool program offers structured early learning in a setting designed for young children's developmental rhythms.

Schedule & Details:

- Tuesdays &/or Thursdays, 9:30 AM – 12:00 PM
- Age-appropriate activities that encourage social skills, language, and play-based exploration
- Small class sizes: maximum 6 children

Our preschool supports each child's natural curiosity while building confidence and readiness for Kindergarten.

KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM

Designed specifically for families intending to homeschool, while providing structured, teacher-led instruction that follows the Alberta Program of Studies.

Program Features

- Full day class on Tuesdays & Thursdays 9:00 AM – 3:05 PM
- Maximum 22 students per class
- Field trips and community learning experiences included
- 475 instructional hours per year

Families who qualify can receive the Alberta Transportation Grant to help with travel costs.

WHAT MAKES OUR PROGRAMS SPECIAL

Students are encouraged to explore practical skills and creative work through activities like STEAM (science, technology, engineering, art and math), music, sign language, gym time and more.

Field trips and local exploration deepen the students' sense of belonging and help them learn about the world around them.

Limited numbers ensure personal attention and responsive support for each child.
